

Gödöllő Statement 2006

PREFACE

Christian Endeavour is a global youth ministry movement under the reign of our Lord, Jesus Christ. It compels young people to make a lifetime covenant to four principles: Confession of Christ, Service for Christ, Loyalty to Christ's Church, and Fellowship with Christ's people. It calls young people to hold one another accountable to these principles and to the daily practice of Christian Endeavour.

VISION

We believe that all young people:

- Are Loved and unconditionally welcomed by God
- Are Created by God for service and significance
- Are Called by Jesus Christ for mission and ministry
- Are Vital to the life of the church of Jesus Christ

MISSION

We determine to be:

- A recruiting organization that encourages young people to commit their lives to the service of Jesus Christ.
- A training organization that equips young people to live daily for Jesus Christ and become servants in his church.
- A mobilizing organization that empowers Christian young people to build the Kingdom of God.

PURPOSE

World Christian Endeavour Union will:

- Foster Service and Support to national Christian Endeavour Unions to help them accomplish their unique goals.
- Foster Communication Platforms to national Christian Endeavour Unions, so they may effectively connect to one another.
- Foster Global Opportunities for national Christian Endeavour Unions to fellowship together in celebration.
- Foster Networking of resources among national Christian Endeavour Unions and introduce additional ministry tools.
- Foster the Expansion of Christian Endeavour by birthing new national Christian Endeavour Unions.
- Foster Relationships which advance the ministry of Christian Endeavour to the greater Body of Christ and the world.

SUMMARY

The action plan needed to accomplish the above statement must be derived by World's Christian Endeavor leadership with the co-operation of all existing national Christian Endeavour Unions. The steps to fulfil the functional aspects of this strategy should reflect the needs of those national organizations. This plan must fit within the resources currently available to World Christian Endeavor while leaving ample opportunity for God to bless our efforts and expand our means. This plan should be available for final acceptance by the fall 2007 meeting of the Board of Directors of World's Christian Endeavor Union.
