Leadership Academies to Begin in 2018

An Update from General Secretary, Dave Coryell

C.E. International Leadership Academies launching January 2018. World Christian Endeavor is making leadership development one of its top priorities. A major step to accomplishing this task involves the launch of its first C.E. International Leadership Academy event in Lagos, Nigeria January 4-7. This event will be followed by additional events in Northeast India, Dubai, and hopefully Guatemala and Wales later in 2018. The event includes Biblical transformational leadership values, Christian Endeavor training, C.E. structure study, Understanding Church Systems and regional networking. Once launched, the goal is to make the C.E. International Leadership Academies one of the strongest Christian development programs available. May God receive the glory as we implement this plan!

Financial Partners needed for 2018 Budget!

The amount given from national unions has increased from \$2000 two years ago to over \$10,000 for this year. Syria & Lebanon

This CE Union has recently ended their summer programs that were very fruitful and encouraging to the youth in their community. Below are updates from these camps.

The Sports Ministry Committee, which operates under the auspices of CE Union, planned a Sports Camp for young athletes for the first time in KCHAG July 24-26, 2017. The purpose of the camp was to see the connection between "Faith and Sports" and to encourage the young athletes to pass their testimony through sports. "Athletes In Action", a global spiritual and sporting organization, helped to make this camp happen. The three-day camp was full of trainings and spiritual topics. We thank God about the annual Youth Camp that took place on July 26-30, 2017 in KCHAG. There were seventy five members from Lebanon and Syria who participated in this camp. The camp speaker was Rev. Nishan Bakalian and the leader was Rev. Raffi Messerlian and there were many leaders that helped with the camp. The general theme of the camp was "To Where?", based on the Bible verse Luke 15:11-32 "The Lost Son". Each day of the camp started with quiet time which was prepared by Mrs. Kayaneh Messerlian, having the following topics: "Your Time", "Your Mind" and "Your Capabilities". It was a great summer in KCHAG especially from July 31-August 5, 2017 when sixty children from different Sunday

Schools of the Armenian Evangelical Churches and organizations gathered along with their leaders to have a joyful, blessed and enjoyable week. During the week, the children learned Psalm 95, had daily quiet times, and had



pleasant singing and worships, spent daily prayer time and had daily continuous story time.

Conventions in North India

Then in 2005, people in the Bangor and Ards area came to me and asked if I would allow my name to go forward as Irish President. Initially, I refused but they were persistent and I agreed to believe that this was another chapter in the plan that God had for me. I served as President for the 2005-2006 year and thoroughly enjoyed traveling about visiting Societies. After that period of service, it came as a surprise to me to be asked to take the position of General Secretary of Irish Christian Endeavor. As I had just retired it became evident that God still had work for me to do and I was elected.
